

Hello!!

I am happy to say that we will be re-opening the Leisure Centre Saturday, May 29th at 9:00 AM. Please read this email carefully and discuss it with your family. There is a bit of info here so read carefully!

In brief... (but please read the details)

1. Enter at your own risk
2. No Guests
3. Stay with your family
4. Sanitize hands when you enter and exit
5. Bathrooms are open
6. Playground is open
7. Basketball is open
8. Staff will supervise that you stay 6 feet away from other groups
9. Staff is not responsible for your children
10. Clean up after your family
11. Failure to follow rules and you will be asked to leave
12. Repeat failure and fob will be suspended
13. Although we are private, we are not privileged to ABH standards/  
government practices

**BEFORE** you or your family members decide to use the centre please take a minute to self assess. **DO NOT ENTER** the leisure centre if you experience **ANY** of the COVID-19 symptoms!

We will open the centre with ALL the Covid-19 government guidelines in place. Physical distancing is mandatory while using the centre. If you cannot follow the guidelines you will be asked to leave and possibly lose fob access. Please be sure the activities you take part in are with your family only and remain 2 meters distance between you and others.

The age for using the centre without an adult is 12 years old. Please consider the health risks for sending small children to the centre unsupervised. The staff are there to help and maintain but they are not responsible for your child no matter the age.

Guests of your household are NO LONGER permitted at this time. We cannot have more than 50 people visiting the centre at any one time. We are putting a hold on ALL guests to allow actual residents of UW their access to the centre.

We will provide sanitizer at the gate. We ask that you sanitize upon entering as well as when leaving. If you have plans to talk to a staff member we ask that you wear a face mask to ensure you as well as staff are safe.

If you wear face masks or gloves to the centre and need to dispose of these items, please ensure they make it to a garbage can. Please clean up after you and your family.

The washrooms will be open for your needs and will be cleaned every half hour or as needed. If possible, please use the washrooms before visiting the centre to avoid possible

spreading of the virus. One of the urinals in the men's washroom is out of use at this time for proper physical distancing.

Please be sure to read all the attached information. It is being sent to you to help you stay healthy and safe as well as keep your community healthy and safe. If we cannot abide by the regulations in effect, we will lose this opportunity to be open. I have attached the centre's basic rules as well as government information on Covid-19 just for your information! :)

Staff will do their best to keep areas clean and sanitized but you are using the leisure centre at your own risk. It is a good idea to bring your own sanitizer and wipes for equipment. To expect staff on standby in each area to sanitize after each person/use is not practical.

We have a new fob system! If you have any issues with your fob, please email me!

At this current time the swimming pool will remain closed for the summer. Right now ABH has pools scheduled for phase 3 of relaunching. We do not know when phase 3 will be in effect and we cannot prepare for this unknown timeline. Although we are a private pool we still are governed by ABH. They will NOT inspect our pool, give it any privilege to open or test our water at this time. I have pressed this topic with them and was given a very FIRM "not until further notice". If by some miracle we move through these phases quickly the HOA is happy to readdress the pool opening.

We are so happy we were able to get the play areas open for your use. We understand this has been a trying time. We truly hope you and your family benefit from having use of the facility! Enjoy, play safe and stay healthy! 🧐
